**ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (ESIA) FOR A PROPOSED OFFSHORE
EXPLORATION WELL DRILLING IN BLOCK 5/6/7, SOUTH-WEST COAST, SOUTH AFRICA**

**NOTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT ESIA REPORT FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT
AND INVITATION TO PUBLIC MEETINGS**

Our correspondence of 29 July 2022 regarding the submission of the final Scoping Report for acceptance refers. This letter provides information on the availability for comment of the draft ESIA Report and invites all stakeholders to attend the public meetings.

BACKGROUND

TotalEnergies EP South Africa Block 567 (Pty) Ltd ("TEEPSA") has applied to the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE) for Environmental Authorisation (EA) to undertake exploration well drilling in Block 5/6/7 off the South-West Coast of South Africa. The Area of Interest is located offshore roughly between Cape Town and Cape Agulhas, approximately 60 km from the coast at its closest point in water depths between 700 m and 3 200 m.

SLR Consulting (South Africa) (Pty) Ltd ("SLR") has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake the ESIA process for the proposed project. This process aims to identify and assess the potential environmental and social impacts and define mitigation measures, where possible, to avoid and reduce significant negative environmental and social impacts, and provide adequate information to the DMRE to make an informed decision.

The final Scoping Report prepared for the proposed project was accepted by the DMRE on 28 August 2022. The DMRE acceptance confirmed that SLR may proceed with the ESIA in accordance with the tasks contemplated in the Plan of Study presented in the final Scoping Report and Appendices 3-6 of the EIA Regulations 2014 (as amended).

Notice is hereby given in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (No. 107 of 1998) (as amended) and the EIA Regulations 2014 (as amended) that the draft ESIA Report has been made available for a 44-day review and comment period from **24 October to 7 December 2022**. This is longer than the legislated 30-day review period in order to provide an opportunity for Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) to comment on any aspect of the proposed project and the findings of the impact assessment.

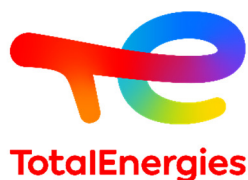
