RE: Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) Process for Proposed Well Drilling Exploration Activities in Block Northern Cape Ultra Deep (NCUD), West Coast, South Africa Availability of Draft Scoping Report and Invitation to Public Open Days / Meetings

Dear Interested and Affected Party,

This letter provides information of the application made by Shell Offshore Upstream South Africa B.V. (Shell) for Environmental Authorisation (EA) to undertake various exploration and appraisal activities (including well drilling and geophysical surveys) in Block Northern Cape Ultra Deep (NCUD), located off the West Coast of South Africa. The area of interest in Block NCUD is located 300 km offshore at its closest point, in water depths ranging from 2 500 m to 3 200 m. Shell (the operator) and its Joint Venture partners currently hold an Exploration Right over Block NCUD.

The EA application has been made in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2014 (as amended), promulgated in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (No. 107 of 1998) (as amended), as the proposed project triggers the following listed activities:

- Listing Notice 1 (R.983 of 2014 as amended): 14, 17, 19A.
- Listing Notice 2 (R.984 of 2014 as amended): 4, 6, 7, 14, 18.

As part of the EA application process, an Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) (which includes public participation) must be undertaken in terms of the EIA Regulations 2014 (as amended). SLR Consulting (South Africa) (Pty) Ltd (SLR) has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner to undertake the ESIA processes for the proposed project.

1. Registration on the Project Stakeholder Database

2. Availability of Draft Scoping Report for Review and Comment

The ESIA process consists of two main phases, namely the Scoping Phase and Impact Assessment Phase, with opportunities for public comment during each phase. Public consultation is a critical component of the ESIA process. This ESIA process is currently in the Scoping Phase where, through a participative process, information about the receiving environment (biophysical and socio-economic) and potential impacts are identified for further consideration.

SLR has compiled a Draft Scoping Report, which is available for a 30-day review and comment period from **8 July to 8 August 2024.** This provides an opportunity for I&APs to comment on any aspect of the proposed project and the potential impacts identified for further investigation in the Impact Assessment Phase.
